Participants in Teen Masters are limited to a single SKILL 3.02 while competing on two low-volume oil patterns. By reducing variables, such as “matching up” and “whom you follow,” we achieve competition in which ***“the hand in the ball is more important than the ball in the hand.”***

The SKILL 3.02 is an incredibly durable pearlized urethane ball that maintains its performance characteristics for years rather than months. The 24 bowlers who advanced to the match play finals of the 2023 Teen Masters Championships used balls over three years old on average, including one with over 500 games.

WHO: Teens from North, Central, and South America and the Caribbean.

SIGN UP FOR THE 2026 CHAMPIONSHIPS

The registration fee is currently \$300 and includes at least 18 games of competition, two personalized 2026 Championships jerseys, a personalized credential, the official practice session, free admission for family and friends, and an estimated \$50,000 in college scholarships.

Step 1: Read this Registration Guide **thoroughly**.

Step 2: Go to TeenMastersBowling.com

Step 3: Click the **2026 Sign Up** button, then click **Sign Up** under Log In to create an account.

Step 4: Complete all details, then click on the **Create Your Account** button at the bottom of the form.

Step 5: Validate your account by inputting the 6-digit code sent to your email.

Step 6: Click the **2026 Sign Up** button again, and use your email and password to **Log In**.

Step 7: Click the **2026 Championships Registration** and add it to your cart.

Step 8: If you do not have a SKILL 3.02 bowling ball, add one to your shopping cart now or later.

The SKILL 3.02 is the only ball allowed at the Championships and will continue to be used in 2027 and beyond. You may bring two SKILL 3.02s to Lansing, but you must designate one for the competition after the official practice session.

Step 9: **Check Out.** *The site accepts credit cards, PayPal, and PayPal Pay Later. PayPal Later allows you to make four interest-free payments.*
